\$14.00 per athlete with unlimited entries; no separate fee for relays. Register online by **March 10** at CoachO.com. \$5.00 late fee. Late entries and game-day changes may be limited to field events and races 800m and longer. After registration, **final** meet schedule and performance lists are posted on [home page](#) and sent to email addresses on file with CoachO.

PACKET PICK UP

Begins at 7:30 a.m. on meet day at ticket booth.

Packets contain meet schedule, bibs, pins and entry list. Team packets must be picked up by a coach or club administrator. Individual bibs will not be distributed from team packets.

STADIUM ENTRY

Gates open at 7:30 a.m.

Parking is located in front of and around stadium. Stop by ticket booth for a spectator or coach **entry band**. Spectator fee is **\$5.00** cash or **\$5.50** with card; fee is waived for 6 and under and 65 and older, and registered athletes.

AROUND THE OVAL

Tents are permitted in bleachers along the top row on home side, and anywhere on visitor side. Uniforms are not required. Tracklab provides batons, starting blocks and youth implements, except poles. Each event is called twice by age group - one first call and one final call. Live results available during meet on [home page](#).

MEDALS

Medals awarded to top 3 finishers per event, and by age group even if event was combined during competition. Coaches, parents or club administrators must pick up youth medals.



Coach bands allow access to infield and other venues during competition. Free coach bands are based on the number of registered athletes: 3-9: 1 band; 10-19: 2 bands; 20-29: 3 bands; 30-39: 4 bands; 40+ 5 bands. Coaches above limit can purchase a coach band for \$5.00.



Athletes should report to Clerking on the first call for their age division; reporting to Clerking outside of age group creates congestion in Clerking. **Only athletes are permitted Clerking unless escorting 10U athletes.** Older athletes should report without an escort. Athletes may not bring electronic devices to Clerking, and must remain in Clerking until escorted to the start line **by Tracklab**. Athletes who leave Clerking before escort risk DNS.




Athletes are permitted 3 jumps and 3 throws. Check-in by reporting to the venue for **that** field event. All youth implements are provided. **Coaches must manage athletes in multiple events.** Field events will not be suspended during track events, and athletes must promptly return to the field event in progress or risk forfeiture. High jump bar is not lowered for returning athletes. No guarantee an age group or field event will not conclude while athlete is away.
